Activities for schools

WORKSHOP 1 – HEIGH HO

TYPE OF WORKSHOP: playing to learn

SUBJECTS INVOLVED: multiple subjects

EDUCATION LEVEL: kindergarten

WORKSHOP ACTIVITIES: With the help of Crabò, children will discover how a typical day of a miner is; in the lamp room, they will be provided with a lamp to hunt the underground area and find coal. Through observation, memory games and action, children will learn a lot about coal mining while having much fun.

EDUCATIONAL OBJECTIVES: observing, playing and finding out more about mining activities and the work of miners, through a fun interaction with other children and museum guides.

LOCATION: museum exhibition area

DURATION: 60 minutes (includes the underground tour)

WORKSHOP 2 - ROLE PLAY

TYPE OF WORKSHOP: team game

SUBJECTS INVOLVED: multiple subjects

EDUCATION LEVEL: 4th and 5th year of primary school, 1st year of middle school

WORKSHOP ACTIVITIES: after talking a little about mines and the work of the miners, an operator will ask the participants to create two teams. They will pretend to be employees, technicians, lamp makers, miners and sorters, and, in a location that reproduces the typical environment where miners used to work, they will play their roles by interacting with each other. The two teams will compete in different research, selection and practical tasks. Each challenge is focused on an aspect discussed during the guided tour.

EDUCATIONAL OBJECTIVES: better understanding the concepts learned and the issues addressed during the guided tour through a fun interaction; promoting group discussion and interaction through role play.

WORKSHOP 3 - MY 40's HOUSE

TYPE OF WORKSHOP: interactive tour to discover ancient locations

SUBJECTS INVOLVED: multiple subjects

EDUCATION LEVEL: primary school, 1st year of middle school

WORKSHOP ACTIVITIES: Zia Noemi will tell the story of her husband Ettore, who came from Manoppello, Abruzzo, to work in the mine. The lady will guide the students through the discovery of her 40's home; they will answer questions from this nice little woman and pass some tests while having much fun.

EDUCATIONAL OBJECTIVES: guiding students through the discovery of modern elements inside old houses in Carbonia and giving them the opportunity to learn more about the daily life of miners and their families outside the mine.

WORKSHOP 4 – THE HISTORY OF COAL

TYPE OF WORKSHOP: educational activity with animation movie

SUBJECTS INVOLVED: geology, science

EDUCATION LEVEL: primary school, middle school

WORKSHOP ACTIVITIES: the operator will illustrate the natural processes that led to the formation of the Sulcis coalfield and the techniques used to identify it. The guide will also explain the main uses of coal.

EDUCATIONAL OBJECTIVES: discovering the area; learning more about the techniques used to identify coal basin, the process leading to coal formation and the main uses of coal.

WORKSHOP 5 – RIDDLES IN THE MINE

TYPE OF WORKSHOP: team game

SUBJECTS INVOLVED: multiple subjects

EDUCATION LEVEL: middle school

WORKSHOP ACTIVITIES: with Morse code messages, brain teasers, word games and riddles, the students will challenge each other in an exciting team game and discover the fascinating world of coal mines.

EDUCATIONAL OBJECTIVES: learning more about mining activities through a fun interaction and promoting group discussion and teamwork.

WORKSHOP 6 – LIGHT IN THE DARK

TYPE OF WORKSHOP: playing to learn

SUBJECTS INVOLVED: science, history, anthropology

EDUCATION LEVEL: primary school, middle school.

WORKSHOP ACTIVITIES: A journey through the last centuries to discover technological innovations, by direct observation of mine lamps: from fat trimming to fish oil, from carbide to electricity. The students will find out more about the different types of lamps exhibited in the museum and the technological innovations occurred over the centuries, observing how a carbide lamp and other commonly used lamps (fish oil and/or electric) work.

EDUCATIONAL OBJECTIVES: stimulate children's curiosity for the study of technological innovations by observing a simple everyday life object of major anthropological and historical interest for the mining sector.
